	COMMERCIAL INVOICE	 Provide electronic copy of the commercial invoice. Customs duties and valued added tax are calculated based on the value of goods and currency. Include EORI of Exporter and Importer. To utilize the customs easement, the Statement on Origin (incl. REX-number of registered exporter if goods value exceed € 6,000) needs to be included.
